Program-Police Districting-Captain Jim Drozdowski-explained all the duties that the Sheriff's Dept. is expected to do. Full time & 8 part time deputies have been laid off because of the 20% cut in the general fund. If you want your Township to be safe-the long term solution would be a Police District. It would help if the sales tax increase would have passed. A 1 mil levy would produce 1.6 million. Many questions were answered by Sheriff Stammitti, Chief Deputy Cavanaugh, & Captain Drozdowski.
